

SINGLE COUNTY DITCH PETITION

Revised code, Secs. 6131.04-6133.02, .03

Petition to reconstruct and maintain an existing drainage system.

December 21, 2017

To the Board of County Commissioners,

Allen County, Ohio

The undersigned hereby petitions your honorable body to reconstruct and maintain an existing drainage system on the course hereinafter set forth.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioner and will be conducive to the public welfare. The Project shall be identified as the **Smith Improvement Project Petitioned Ditch #1332**.

The following is the proposed course and termini of the project to wit:

Commencing 320 feet north of the SW Corner of the NW Quarter of Section 21, T 2 S, R 6 E, American Township, Allen County, Ohio. This point being approximately 15 feet south of the north property line of Parcel 36-2100-02-012.001 and 60 feet east of the centerline of Baty Road.

Thence continuing north adjacent to Baty Road approximately 575 feet to an existing culvert. Thence continuing west through the existing culvert under Baty Road approximately 3,400 feet west/ northwest to its confluence with the Steinke Petitioned Ditch #1253, south of East Road.

The existing drainage system was previously constructed as through Ohio Revised Code 6131, as Smith Petitioned Ditch #466 in 1909.

All costs of field investigation, surveying, engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land, except as ordered under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code. All work within the road right-of-way will not be assessed the parcels in the watershed.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for:

Replace and/or repair the existing drainage system with a new drainage system that is adequate in size to alleviate the drainage issues within the watershed, as deemed necessary by the Allen County Engineer. The project shall include storm sewer drainage improvements within and outside of the the road right-of-way.

A list of the names and addresses, where known, of all the owners of the land which the petitioner or the County Engineer claims will be benefited or damaged by the construction of the proposed improvement will be supplied by the County Engineer's Office.

Service of notice of the filing of the Petition shall be obtained by mailing notices and publication as provided in Sec. 6131.07, Revised Code.

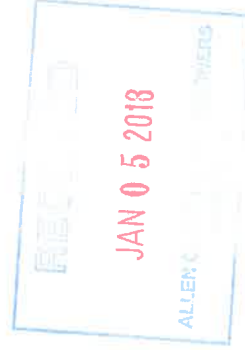

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Michael A. Kleman, as principal and as surety, is held and firmly bound unto Allen County, Ohio, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars and 00/100, to the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, we do hereby jointly and several bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That, Whereas, on the 5th day of January, 2018, the above bound Michael A. Kleman, filed a petition with the Clerk of the County Commissioners of Allen County, Ohio, making application to the County Commissioners to:

Replace and/or repair the existing drainage system with a new drainage system that is adequate in size to alleviate the drainage issues within the watershed, as deemed necessary by the Allen County Engineer. The project shall include storm sewer drainage improvements within and outside of the road right-of-way.

Petitioned for by Michael A. Kleman, the following being the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

The petitioners will pay the cost of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the costs incurred by the Engineer in making his preliminary reports, if the prayer of the petition is not granted or if the petition is for any cause dismissed, unless the Board of County Commissioners decides to pay the Engineer's costs from this Bond in accordance with Section 6131.09 of the Revised Code, then this obligation shall be void; otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
